### **COST TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS FOR CONTESTANTS:**

**EACH CONTESTANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO SELL 30 RAFFLE TICKETS WITH A PRIZE TO THE ONE SELLING THE MOST. PROCEEDS WILL GO TO THE PAGEANT FUND.**

### **PRELIMANARIES**

All contestants entering will be accepted. Although if the pageant committee receives 15 or more completed applications by the deadline of June 1, 2010, there may be a preliminary judging.

The judging for the preliminary will be completed using the same scoring criteria as listed above. Preliminaries will be held the afternoon of the pageant. At this time all contestants will be interviewed and a small pageant in front of the judges will take place. This will be open to the public. After all judging is completed the official pageant auditor will tally the scores and determine a top ten. The results will be sealed in an envelope to be announced at the pageant, after the Junior Miss production number. The top ten girls will then compete in their pageant dresses on stage in front of the judges. A score will be added to their previous score to determine the winners. The remaining contestants not in the top ten will be seated in a reserved seating area to watch the rest of the pageant. Should a Preliminary Judging be necessary, it will be announced after the deadline date of June 1, 2010

GENERAL RULES

REGISTRATION DEADLINE - **MONDAY**, June 1, 2009

- Candidates must be between the ages of 11 and 13 as of July 13, 2010.
- Scoring is as follows:
  - Formal Attire & Modeling 25
  - Interview 35
  - Impromptu Question 20
  - Speech and Stage Presence 20
  - Total points 100
- Interview: This will be a timed event-three (3) minutes for each girl.
- Formal Attire: A formal dress should be appropriate for 11 to 13 years old. The dress should not be an evening gown. It should be a nice Easter Sunday or wedding attendance dress. The Pageant Director or chairperson must review all dresses.
- Speech Competition: Topic will be \_\_\_\_\_. Please limit the speech to 30 seconds. You will use a hand held microphone, no podium.
- Impromptu Question: The question will be the same question for all contestants. Immediately following the speech.
- Modeling: Candidates will be required to attend all workshop/practices prior to the contest for modeling and judging competitions.
- Dressing Room: No parents or guardians will be allowed in the dressing room.
- No parents or guardians will be allowed at any practice in order to have the contestant's full attention.

In view of the above and further in view of the informal nature of this contest, and in consideration of the acceptance of my application to compete as a candidate for Mercer County Fair Queen, I hereby forever release, indemnify and agree to hold the Mercer County Fair Board, its agents, employees, directors and judges, entirely harmless from any liability for any errors, defects, irregularities or unfairness, or injuries or damages which may arise directly or indirectly from my participation as a candidate in the contest.
